- 2. With the rest of the Scientific and Technical panel, agree a shortlist of speakers for your session,
- 3. Liaise with selected speakers, and confirm their attendance,
- 4. Chair the session.

Potential session topics should have a broad appeal across science and technology, ideally focussed on areas within (but <u>not limited to)</u> the following interests for the conference:

Earth System Measurements, Models and science; Long-term climate and environmental change; Earth Observation Applications and Services; Hazards and risks; Remote Sensing from space to ground; New EO Technologies including instruments, missions, UAVs and platforms; Data assimilation; Data Management, Services and Products; Developments in digital EO and digital twins; Photogrammetric Methods and 3D Imaging; Earth Observation in Education.

In addition sessions that bring together upstream and downstream /science and industry communities are particularly welcome.

Your proposal should include a short description of up to 150 words and a nominee who will Chair the session.
